

Display the eZ Website Toolbar

EZP Version >= 5.3

Configuring the display of the Website Toolbar

To have the regular Webin Toolbar, first add the proper CSS file to your head template : `extension/ezwt/design/standard/stylesheets/websitetoolbar.css`

```
<style type="text/css">
    @import url("{{
asset('extension/ezwt/design/standard/stylesheets/websitetoolbar.css') }}");
</style>
```

Then, in your template, you can add the Webin Toolbar by defining the display of the `websiteToolbarAction` from the `ezpublish_legacy.website_toolbar.controller` Controller

```
{% if location is defined %}
{{ render(controller
"ezpublish_legacy.website_toolbar.controller:websiteToolbarAction", { 'locationId':
location.id} ) ) }}
{% endif %}
```

Redirection after publishing

Versions: 5.3.4, 5.4.1.

In order to get properly redirected after publishing or discarding, overrides of legacy's `content/edit.tpl` must include the `content/edit_redirection.tpl`. It adds hidden fields required by legacy for those redirections.

```
<form method="POST" action="content/edit/...">
<!---->
{include uri="design:content/edit_redirection.tpl"}
</form>
```

About the website_toolbar controller

The `websiteToolbarAction` renders the whole Webin Toolbar, and if the logged in user doesn't have the required permission, an empty response is returned
