## Description

This Field Type makes possible to store and retrieve a url. It is formed by the combination of a link and the respective text.

## Input expectations

Type	Example
string	"http://www.ez.no", "eZ Systems"

## Value object

### Properties

The Value class of this field type contains the following properties:

Property	Type	Description
\$link	string	This property will be used to store the link provided to the value of this Field Type.
\$text	string	This property will be used to store the text to represent the stored link provided to the value of this Field Type.

#### Value object content example

```
$url->link = "http://www.ez.no";  
$url->text = "eZ Systems";
```

### Constructor

The `Url\Value` constructor will initialize a new Value object with the value provided. It expects two comma-separated strings, corresponding to the link and text.

### Constructor example

```
// Instantiates an Url Value object
$UrlValue = new Url\Value( "http://www.ez.no", "eZ Systems" );
```
